- 4) Treasurer's Report:

The current Balances for the accounts as of May 20th at 4:50pm are:

- Council Chequing Balance: \$10,813.06 BUT approximately 821.71 of that money is from
 donations for specific items and cannot be used for items outside of that scope. That leaves
 the account balance at 9991.35. There is approximately \$14,000.00 needed to cover known
 expenses and the remainder of the events planned for the year (\$10,000 for field trips,
 \$176.93 for pizza prize, \$675 for sports day, \$300 for kinder grad, \$1200 for subway hot
 lunch, \$1362 for club moo).
- We are trying to find companies to sponsor the remaining events but there will still need to be money moved from the fundraising account to the council account at some point. At this time that amount is unknown but once it is known it will be brought forward in a Facebook group chat as we don't have any more in person meetings planned for the rest of the year.
- Fundraising Chequing Balance: \$14521.21 BUT \$7678.45 is a pending cheque for Scholastic's. So, balance will be \$6842.76
- Total Operating Balances: \$25,334.27
- Total Savings Balance: \$105,211.51
